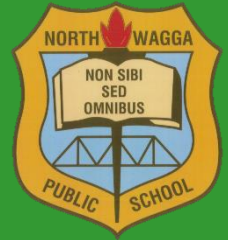

Students can wear Christmas clothes and bring in a Christmas goodie to donate!

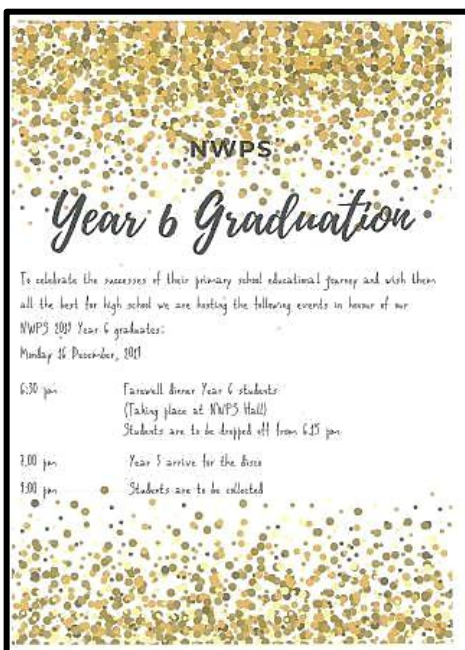
SRC NEWS

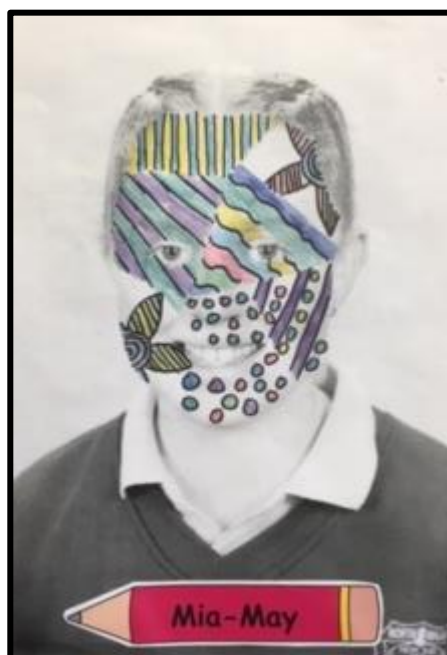
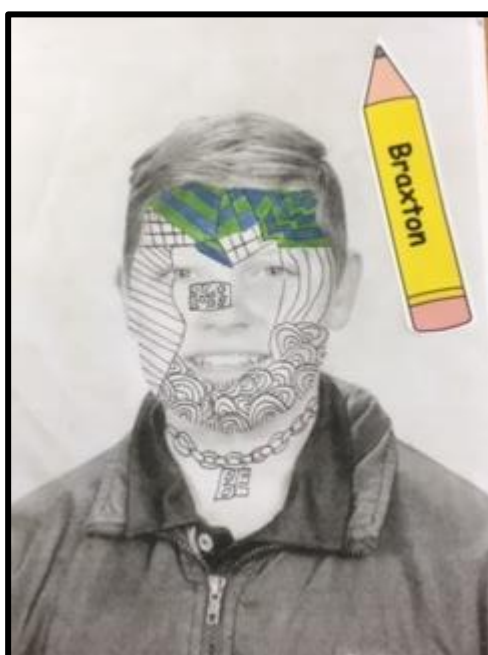
