PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

The weeks just keep getting busier as we head into the final ten days of school. A reminder that tomorrow is a mufti-day so that everyone's uniform is crisp, clean and ready to go for tomorrow night's presentation night. There is no need for a gold coin donation, but if families are happy to have their pantries raided for a food item that could go towards our Vinnies Food Appeal, that would be very generous. Let's make tomorrow's mufti day a Christmas theme, so as much red and green as possible.

Today Mrs Johanson and I were at Learning Management Business Reform (LMBR) launch. This is the new finance system that all government schools across NSW will go live with as it rolls out over 2017. This administration change will be the most significant change to how budgets and money have been handled in schools in over twenty years. A complete change in systems and processes will filter down to families with things as simple as excursions all having to be paid for at least a week in advance, with no "wiggle room" for people who have forgotten to pay by that date. We will review our excursion policy, but essentially we will need to navigate these changes together as we all get used to new guidelines that are not being imposed at our school level, but a new state-wide level. Thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.

As we move into school holidays, allow me to put out a plea to our families. By the time mid-January rolls around and your mind shifts slightly to a return to school and uniforms. Please ensure you're thinking BLACK SHOES for school. We live in really good times and gone are the days where the only black school shoes are heavy, leather lace-ups. Think functionally and practically, perhaps families can look for sport's shoes/joggers that are black? A great compromise, and one that will get our students back into full school uniform. You may have noticed the different standard of uniforms in our class photos this year as I insisted only students in black shoes were in the front row, and Mrs Crane made herself available on the day to ensure everyone was in the same shade of green for their jumpers. Both of these things brought a real WOW factor to our uniforms and school photos and were a wonderful reflection of our students and school. That's what we are striving for every day, thank you for your support in this.

Some Stage 2 students brought a proposal to me recently around starting a "Games Club" at our school. Using their initiative, leadership and negotiation skills have really served them well and this Friday I will take them to the shops to make some purchases of some new board games for a club which will be available to any students who wants to be involved in quieter activities such as board or card games. Well done to Greg, Cruz, Jed and Rylan, nice work kids!

Finally, thanks to all who were able to make it last week to our helpers morning tea. I know there are a lot of people who roll their sleeves up for our school who were unable to make it, so it's always regretful when we can't share a cuppa with you too. Thank you to everyone who contributes to our school and makes it a wonderful place for learning and play for our students.

If a student has already been approved for school travel and their address, school or name changes, their details must be updated by the Parent/Guardian online at the Transport NSW website. Also, ALL students entering Kindergarten, Year 3 or Year 7 in 2017 MUST have their details updated at the Transport NSW website.
