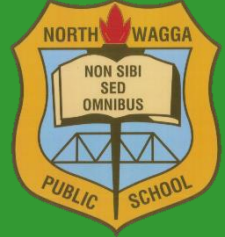

PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT DAY

How great is it to be back at school!?! Our staff got a head start, one day ahead of the students, with a full day of professional learning yesterday. Their agenda included learning around the School Excellence Framework and External Validation, the new Literacy and Numeracy Learning Progressions, and explicit teaching around Learning Intentions and Success Criteria to enhance student learning opportunities and outcomes. The highlight of the day, however, involved staff from Koorungal Public and The Bidgee School who joined us for a two hour session on Trauma Sensitive Practice. This session was presented by Mrs Marianne Mitchell, Principal at the Bidgee School, and was confronting, thought provoking, informative and above all else, excellent in the content and message around how we cater for all our students. Many thanks to Marianne for the amazing insight into the latest research into early brain development, with a particular emphasis on students who have experienced significant trauma.

LAST WEEK OF TERM 2

In the final week, three of our classes honed their cooking skills in the staff

room as their units of studies in nutrition and procedure writing culminated in cooking that was enjoyed by the whole class. Blue Class cooked a wonderful vegetable and pasta soup, Red Class cooked pumpkin scones and Yellow Class cooked pizza. What a great way to celebrate the end of learning!

We finished last term with a great day of celebrations around NAIDOC Week. All teachers led different activities around Aboriginal arts, crafts, cooking, games and stories. This was complemented by all students also having cultural activities with Mr Mark Sadler. Well done to everyone for such a great day of fun and participation.
