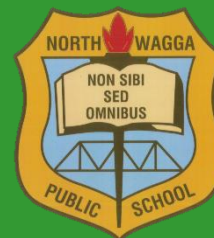

NSW Health Advice

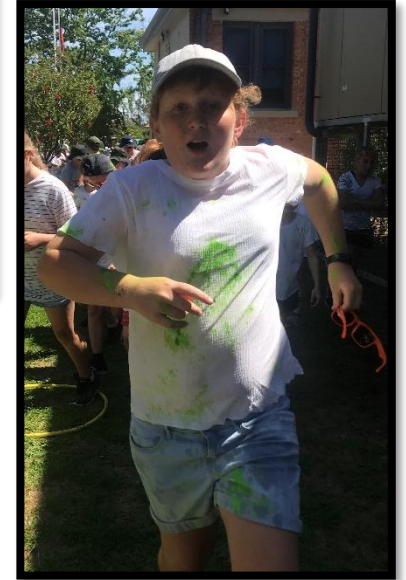

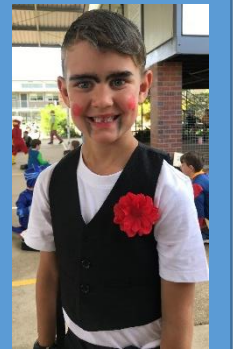
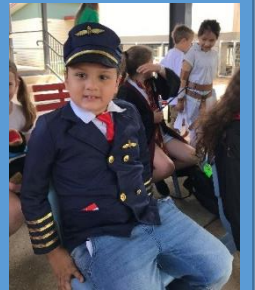
