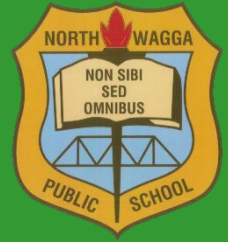

PRINCIPALS MESSAGE

Hello and welcome to week 5!

Uniform and rebranding

I have been in consultation with the P&C about reviewing our uniform, the policy states this needs to be done every 3 years. Unfortunately, we have been unable to source the grey pants for the girls and we have been notified that they are completely stopping production of these. This has led us to the decision to change our uniform significantly, with unanimous support from the P&C. We will maintain the bottle green but remove the yellow and introduce navy blue. We are also endeavouring to streamline the options available, making it easier for families to afford. I will be sharing the new designs with you via a zoom Q&A once the story boards return from the uniform supplier. We hope to introduce the new uniform in 2021 with the new kindergarten students starting with the new design. The current uniform will be phased out over a two year period so there will be no need to get rid of current uniforms that may have just been purchased. We are also endeavouring to supply every child with a 'top and bottom' to get the new uniform started. I am very excited that we will have an identity of our own as there are currently 5 other Wagga and surrounding schools with yellow and green uniforms.

To be unified with the new uniform colours we have enlisted the help of a graphic designer to develop a new logo and correspondence design. Our current correspondence is varied and certainly isn't uniformed consisting of bright green, yellow and brown logo and cartoon people. This will be voted upon by staff, students and parents in the coming weeks.

Although this is a lot of change all at once, it is a very exciting chapter moving forward for our beautiful school.

NAIDOC Week

The theme for NAIDOC Week 2020 is *Always Was, Always Will Be*. During this week, students will be participating in NAIDOC Week activities as a celebration of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and a chance to acknowledge their history, culture and achievements. Students are also invited to accessorise their school uniform this Friday with yellow, black and red.

The Cooler Classrooms Program is a \$500 million, five-year investment by the NSW Government to improve learning environments in public schools across NSW.

We are committed to delivering a quality, sustainable and cost effective program to ensure our students enjoy the healthy and comfortable learning environments.

Scope of works

At your school, the program will deliver:

- Air conditioning and fresh air ventilation in 5 classrooms

Progress summary

An air conditioning, heating and fresh air ventilation solution has been designed to meet the scope of works. JRC Electrical Pty Ltd has been awarded the installation contract.

Installation works to begin

Installation works will begin Term 4, 2020.

Work will take place between approx 7am and 5pm, Monday – Friday and 7:30am – 3:30pm on Weekends.

It is estimated construction works may take up to 12 weeks. An installation plan has been developed to minimise disruption of construction works on school operations.

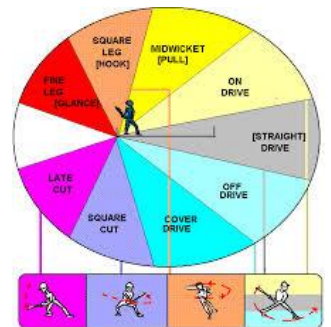
We will continue to work with the contractor, JRC Electrical Pty Ltd, to ensure any disruption to our neighbours is kept to a minimum.

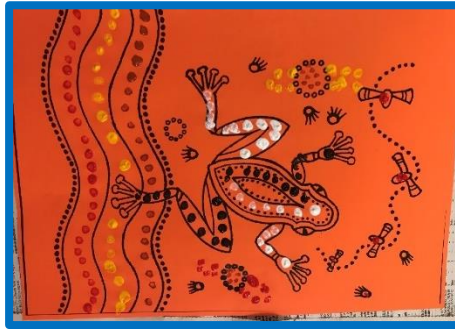

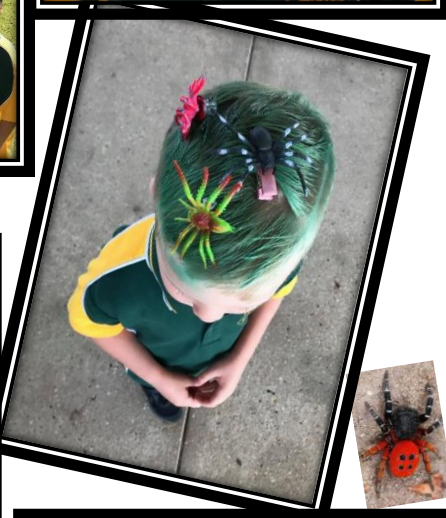

OUT OF SCHOOL HOURS CARE

Dear parents

We want to offer families more flexibility with their work commitments and child care arrangements and to create more opportunities across the whole community. Having Out of School Hours Care available at local schools is a great way to achieve this.

As part of the NSW Government's \$120 million Before and After School Care (BASC) commitment, parents at all NSW schools were recently invited to complete a Have Your Say survey. The survey asked parents to tell us how they are using Out of School Hours Care, how much it costs them, whether they plan to keep using it, and what difficulties they experience in accessing it. The survey results have helped us to better understand the needs of families and what's important to them.

SAFETY AROUND SCHOOL ZONES

Important school zone signs



No Parking
Stop here for up to two minutes to drop off and pick up passengers. You must stay within three metres of your vehicle at all times. No parking zones provide a safe place to drop off or pick up children.
PENALTY EXCEEDS \$191 + 2 demerit points



No Stopping
Do not stop here for any reason. No stopping zones keep sight lines clear for drivers and children. Drivers also must not stop at the side of a road marked with a continuous yellow line. This line means the same as no stopping.
PENALTY EXCEEDS \$344 + 2 demerit points



Bus Zone
Can only be used if driving a bus. A Bus Zone allows buses to drop off and pick up passengers safely.
PENALTY EXCEEDS \$344 + 2 demerit points



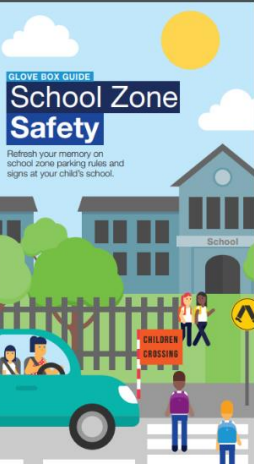
Children Crossing
Change children crossing flags and hand-held stop signs must be obeyed.
PENALTY EXCEEDS \$672 + 4 demerit points for stopping on or near children's crossing



Speeding
Speeding increases the chance of a crash resulting in severe trauma and injury. It's not worth the risk.
Min penalty exceeds \$431 + 2 demerit points
MAX PENALTY \$3695 + 7 demerit points



Running a red light
You have run a red light if your vehicle crosses the white stop line after the lights turn red.
PENALTY EXCEEDS \$572 + 4 demerit points

We all have a responsibility to keep each other safe.

Road safety is a shared responsibility. Keep children safe by following the road rules, particularly in school zones. Traffic rules and parking restrictions are there to improve safety around schools. We all have a role to play in keeping children safe. Next time you are in a school zone here are some simple tips to follow:

- ▶ Waiting in the no stopping zone is illegal and unsafe
- ▶ It's illegal and unsafe to stop on a children's crossing – even to let children out of a car
- ▶ Don't queue for a spot. Drive around the block if you can't find a park
- ▶ U-turns, three-point turns are dangerous, and it's safest to avoid reverse parking outside a school
- ▶ Drop off and pick up children on the school-side of the road
- ▶ The safest door on a car is the kerbside rear door
- ▶ Stay buckled up until the vehicle has stopped
- ▶ No mobile phones
- ▶ You must not stop or park in a bus zone for any reason (including queuing or waiting for a space) unless you are driving a bus. If times are shown on the sign, you are not allowed to stop during those times



Common parking rules



Stopping in a bus zone
You must not stop or park in a bus zone unless you are driving a bus.
PENALTY EXCEEDS \$344 + 2 demerit points



Parking across driveways and footpaths
Don't stop across a driveway or footpath in a school zone, not even to drop off or pick up students.
PENALTY EXCEEDS \$344 + 2 demerit points



Stopping in intersections
Don't stop within 10 metres of an intersection.
PENALTY EXCEEDS \$457 + 2 demerit points



Parking near pedestrian crossing
You must not stop on or within 20 metres before a pedestrian crossing or 10 metres after a pedestrian crossing.
PENALTY EXCEEDS \$457 + 2 demerit points



Double parking
Don't stop on a road between the centre of the road and another vehicle that is parked at the side of the road, to wait or pick up or drop off passengers.
PENALTY EXCEEDS \$344 + 2 demerit points



U-Turns
You can be penalised for dangerous U-turns in a school zone.
PENALTY EXCEEDS \$344 + 2 demerit points
