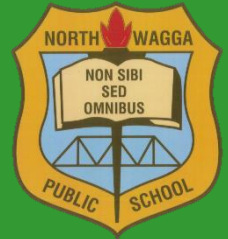

NSW Health Advice

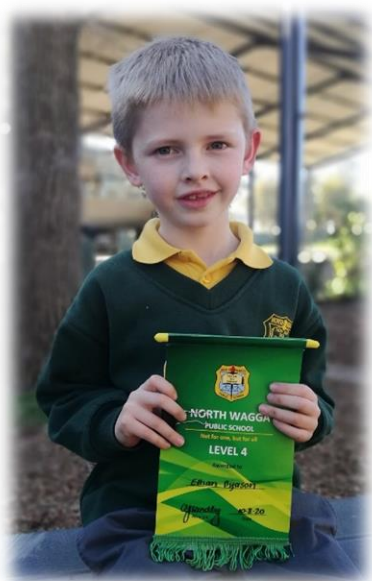

Check-in assessment

Check-in assessment for Year 3 and 5

Dear parents and carers,

Year 3 / Year 5 students will participate in a new reading and numeracy check-in assessment in Term 3, 2020.

The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online reading and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor Year 3/5 student learning following the period of learning from home.

The Check-in assessments can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

- The assessment will be scheduled for our **Year 5** students **Week 6** Thursday – Reading, Friday – Mathematics.
- The assessment will be scheduled for our **Year 3** students **Week 10** Monday – Reading, Tuesday – Mathematics.

Students with disability may receive the same level of support during the assessment that they would normally receive in the classroom.

Please note:

Students will be asked to bring headphones or earbuds that plug into a computer to enable them to hear audio during the assessment. Earbuds used for mobile phones or other portable devices may be suitable for use during the assessment. The type of computer connection needed is a jack or USB.

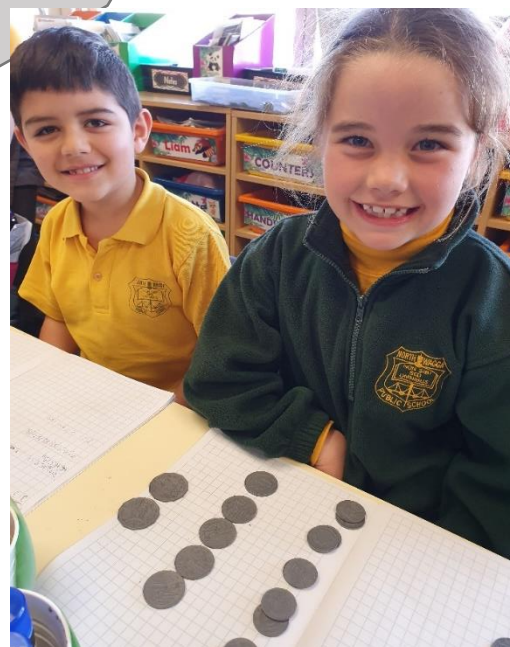

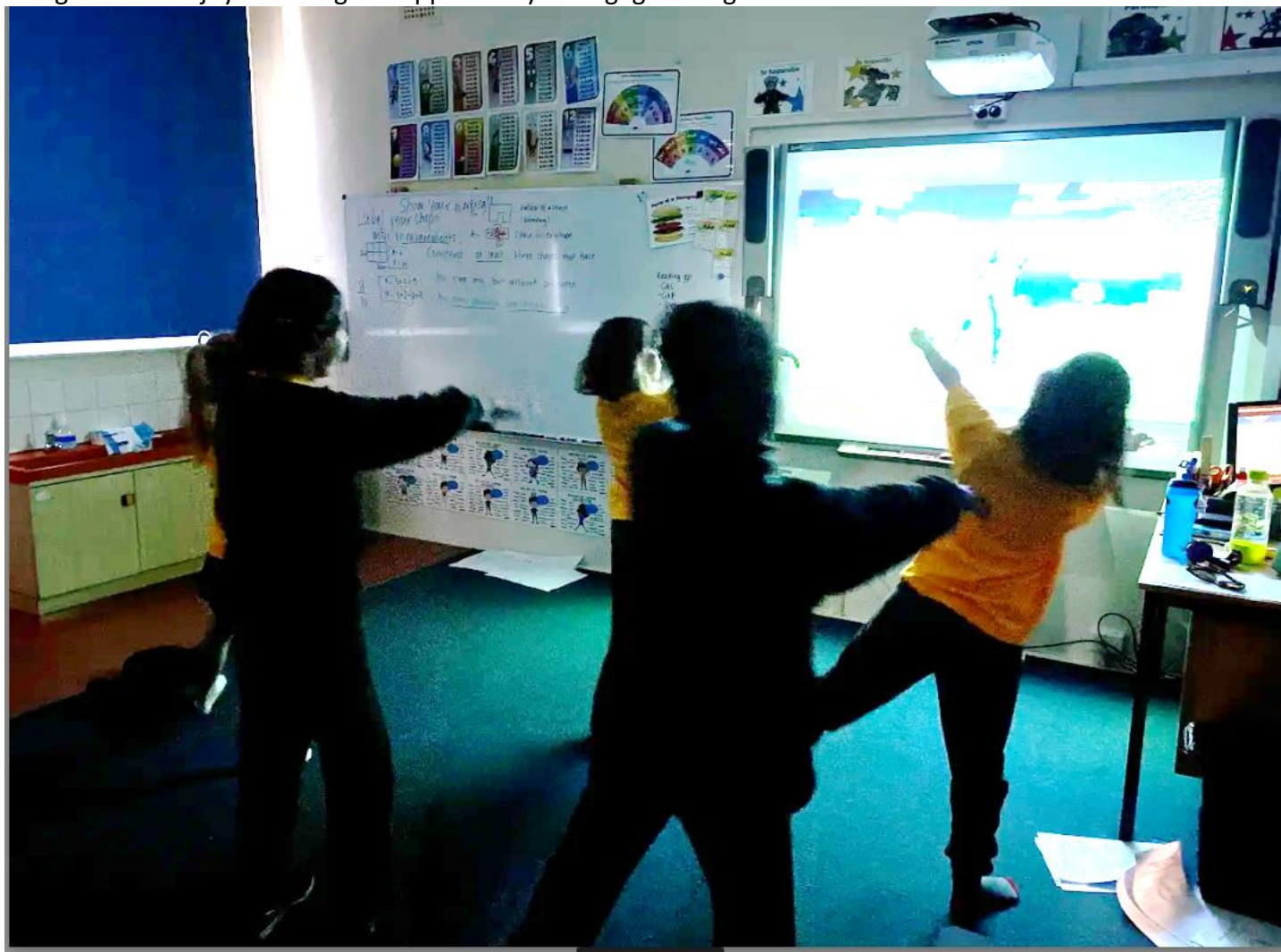
Mathematics in 4/5 White

TELL THEM FROM ME SURVEY

This term, our school will be participating in the *Partners in Learning* parent survey, another part of the *Tell Them From Me* suite of surveys (student, teacher and parent surveys) on student engagement. The survey asks parents and carers questions about different factors that are known to impact on student wellbeing and engagement.

Running this survey will help our school understand parents' and carers' perspectives on their child's experience at school. These include: communication between parents/carers and staff, activities and practices at home and parent/carer views on the school's support of learning and behaviour. This valuable feedback will help our school make practical improvements.

The survey is conducted entirely online on smartphones, iPads, tablets, laptops or computers. The survey will typically take 15 minutes or less to complete and is completely confidential. The parent survey will be conducted over term 3 and early term 4. Although participating in the survey is entirely voluntary, your responses are very much appreciated.
