COVID UPDATE

As you are aware there have been changes to the way schools are operating for the start of this term.

The Department has devised a 4-level system for COVID-safe school operations.

North Wagga Public School is currently operating under Level 2 restrictions, as per the advice of the NSW Department of Health and the NSW Department of Education. What does this mean for students?

All students from NWPS will be resuming face-to-face learning on site from Tuesday 13th July 2021.

What will Level 2 restrictions look like at our school?

There are some revised guidelines that our school must adhere to:

- All students are expected to be at school unless they have even the mildest of COVID-19 symptoms, COVID-19 symptoms include fever, cough, sore or scratchy throat, shortness of breath, or loss of smell or taste. Any student or staff member displaying any COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home and should not return until they have received a negative test result and are symptom-free. In circumstances where children have other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms a letter from their GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.
- There will be restricted access to non-essential visitors (including parents/carers). Unfortunately, during this time parents/carers will not be able to enter the school site to drop off or pick up their child/children, attend assemblies or other school-based activities. Drop off and pick up will take place outside the school gates, whereby I will continue to meet and greet students each morning. We understand that drop off can be a challenge, we do however, need to comply with the guidelines. Staff will also supervise the departure of students at the conclusion of the day. Please have a conversation with your child to organise a meeting point outside the school for the end of the day.
- Overnight and out of local government area excursions are currently not allowed to proceed. We will carefully monitor the situation in relation to the Stage 2 & 3 excursions.

 Whilst school may look a little different for some over the next few weeks, the last time that we as

a school community faced this challenge, we were able to work together to make a difficult situation positive.

We thank you for your understanding and continued support during this time of change and look forward to seeing our students tomorrow when they return from their holiday break.


